Who Should Take This Test:

The US English Spelling Test is designed for both native English speakers and non-native speakers at the intermediate to advanced level.

Non-native speakers at the beginning level may find this test too challenging and may prefer to take the U.S. English Basic Skills Test for Non-native Speakers.

What the Test Is About:

The questions on this multiple-choice test cover tricky spelling patterns and commonly misspelled words.

Duration

The test consists of 40 multiple choice questions and the duration is approximately 34 minutes.

Instructions:

- Each question has between 2 and 8 options. One or more answers may be correct.
- Attempt all questions since there are no penalties for incorrect answers.
- Each question must be answered in the time limit shown at the top of the test window.
- The test is best viewed using Internet Explorer 6.0+, Mozilla Firefox 2.0+ or Google Chrome.
- You must answer each question before proceeding to the next question. You will not be able to change an answer once you've moved to the next question.
- If you leave the test midway through your session, you can resume it where you left off by returning to this page.
